In 2022, Martina received the highest accolade in a room filled with high-level achievers. Known as the 'Oscars for Technology Entrepreneurs', the judges recognized her outstanding personal and company achievements by awarding her with the "Special Achievement Award." Under her leadership Featurespace continues to go from strength to strength, picking up a Queen's Award for Enterprise Innovation in 2021, alongside 15 industry awards for fraud and financial crime risk protection.
